#### 7. Matters Arising from the Minutes.

a. <u>Lodge Maintenance</u>:

Replacement windows: Photographs of the windows have been taken and sent to Architectural Bronze Casements Ltd for them to supply a ball park figure for the cost of replacement windows.

- **c. Hobbs Memorial**: Clerk to ask Chris to clean the memorial
- **d.** <u>War Memorial</u>: It had been agreed to transfer this to the Planning & Conservation Committee
- e. <u>Trees</u>: Quotation for Phase 1 of the tree management for work to trees 2064 and 2070 received in the sum of £1590 + vat. This sum is within the current year's budget. It was <u>recommended</u> by 3 votes in favour and 1 against that the quotation be accepted.
- f. Survey of top field: Waiting the outcome of the survey
- **g.** Hedges: Money will be built up in the budget to enable the Committee to look at this again at a later date
- h. <u>Broken railing by the gates</u>: Quotation received from Arthur Cole for the repairs to the broken railings and the gate stays in the sum of £600 + vat It was <u>recommended</u> that this be accepted.
- i. <u>Tubs by the Chapel</u>: Cllrs Parker and Tye to look at pots to sit inside the tubs.

- <u>Safety of headstones</u>: Cllrs Woollard, R. Campbell and H. Parker had carried out a further check of the headstones. It was suggested that photographs be taken of any headstones that need checking. Discuss further at the next meeting.
