## **Work Experience**

It was reported that Tobie Champion is working 16 hours a week during the summer holidays. It was agreed to check with Lackham College whether he would be continuing with his course and if so whether he would still wish to continue as the Work Experience Student. A meeting will need to be arranged with Lackham College for early September to discuss this. If he wishes to continue the syllabus for the forthcoming year will need to be considered. If not the Council would need to look at the possibility of an alternative Work Experience Student.

The Annual Appraisals had been held in April 2021 and the next Full Appraisal will be carried out in April 2022. Cllr Case will meet with the Staff in November for the six month review.
