- **<u>6.</u> Planning Applications**: The following planning applications were considered:
  - PL/2023/00729 2 Valens Terrace Rear single storey extension to kitchen dining area. Materials to match existing brickwork and roof tiles
    It was felt that the plans are missing too much detail to consider them. Clerk to ask if this could be deferred until the next meeting
    PL/2023/02377 Henley Wood, Henley Lane, Box Construction of vehicular access

Objections. This is in the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. There is an highways issue as the verge in question is Wiltshire Council land and the proposals would damage this permanently. The Parish Council would also question whether the ownership is as shown on the plan. It is felt that the proposed construction of a new vehicular access would still not be adequate for lorries accessing the property. Henley Court, which is adjacent to this site, was refused permission for a similar access on highway grounds

The property is in a Conservation Area and AoNB and permission should have been obtained prior to the work. Clerk to notify Wiltshire Council.
