- 1. **Apologies.** To receive any apologies (and acceptance) for absence.
- 2. Public Question Time.
- 3. **Declarations** of interest relating to items on the Agenda.
- 4. **Previous Minutes**. To receive the Minutes of the previous **Highways Committee on 8**th **September** and to consider any matters arising from the Minutes.
- 5. **Metro Counts.** To note that 5 metro counts have been requested in support of the re-erection of the SIDs across the Parish:
 - a. Wadswick. This is confirmation of traffic speeds after new signage.
 - b. A4. Bassets and Budgens garage.
 - c. Leafy Lane (near the Dandelion café.
 - d. Bradfield Road (near the school).
 - e. A365. Approach to Box from 5-ways.
- 6. Traffice Regulation Orders (LHFIG September 25)
 - a. To agree a new footway and resurfacing/drainage works, at a cost of £625 towards the topo survey so a design can be undertaken. (as per the LHFIG minutes) at the A4 near the Budgens garage.
 - b. Double Yellow Lines and Bus bays at A365 (top of Chapel Lane), Valens Terrace waiting area and Ashley. To agree the costs of £1,587 (25% contribution).
 - c. Dropped kerb at A4 / Middlehill junction- ongoing.
 - d. Kingsdown Road Horse signage. Part of recent visit from Senior Highways Engineer. Costs contribution awaited.
 - e. Ditteridge and Bradford Road. Deer warning signs and road safety signs for horse-riders awaiting costs after visit.
- 7. **SIDs.** To note that the cost of a bespoke pole and slot system is £550 (£400 for the slot). The intention is to re-erect the two Parish-owned SIDs at the earliest possible time. There is a active dialogue with the Head Highways Commissioning on what steps are required.
- 8. Road Safety.
 - a. To note the submission of an 'urgent' issues request to enhance road safety at the Old Jockey road junction.

- b. To note the submission of an issues sheet for the potentially high risk junction of White Ennox Lane and the B3109.
- c. Speed reduction requests. To note the ongoing request for a speed reduction at the Upper Common.

9. Car Parks.

- a. Market Place. To approve the right hand side wall repair cost, as a 50/50 share with Wiltshire Council. See quote for £3,350.
- b. Disabled Spaces and Potholes. Materials now received and will be completed in November / December (includes Valens Terrace). This includes the switch of disabled bay at the Market Place as ageed with Wiltshire Council.
- c. Unauthorised cars. Although reported, no action has yet been taken to remove the two cars from the Selwyn Hall car park.
- d. EV charging. To note that having an EV point is a future aspiration.
- 10. **Signage**. To note the requirement to replace the sign at:
 - a. Top of Valens Terrace.
 - New road signs for Market Place and The Parade have been completed by Wiltshire Council.
- 11. **Correspondence**. To receive any urgent correspondence.
 - a. Cllr Chamberlain forwarded note from a Hazelbury Hill resident to inform the Parish that a 'volume and size' traffic counter had been put in place at the planned DYL location.
 - b. Cllr Johnston highlighted a request to remove a metal barrier on a narrow footpath at Rudloe.
- 12. Rights of Way. No items.
- 13. Items for Parish Steward. The tractor-cut of Mill Lane will be completed in early November.
- 14. **Forward Plan.** To review and to note the latest Forward Plan, including the Policy matrix and Risk Assessments.
